Timeframe: 01/07/2011–30/06/2014

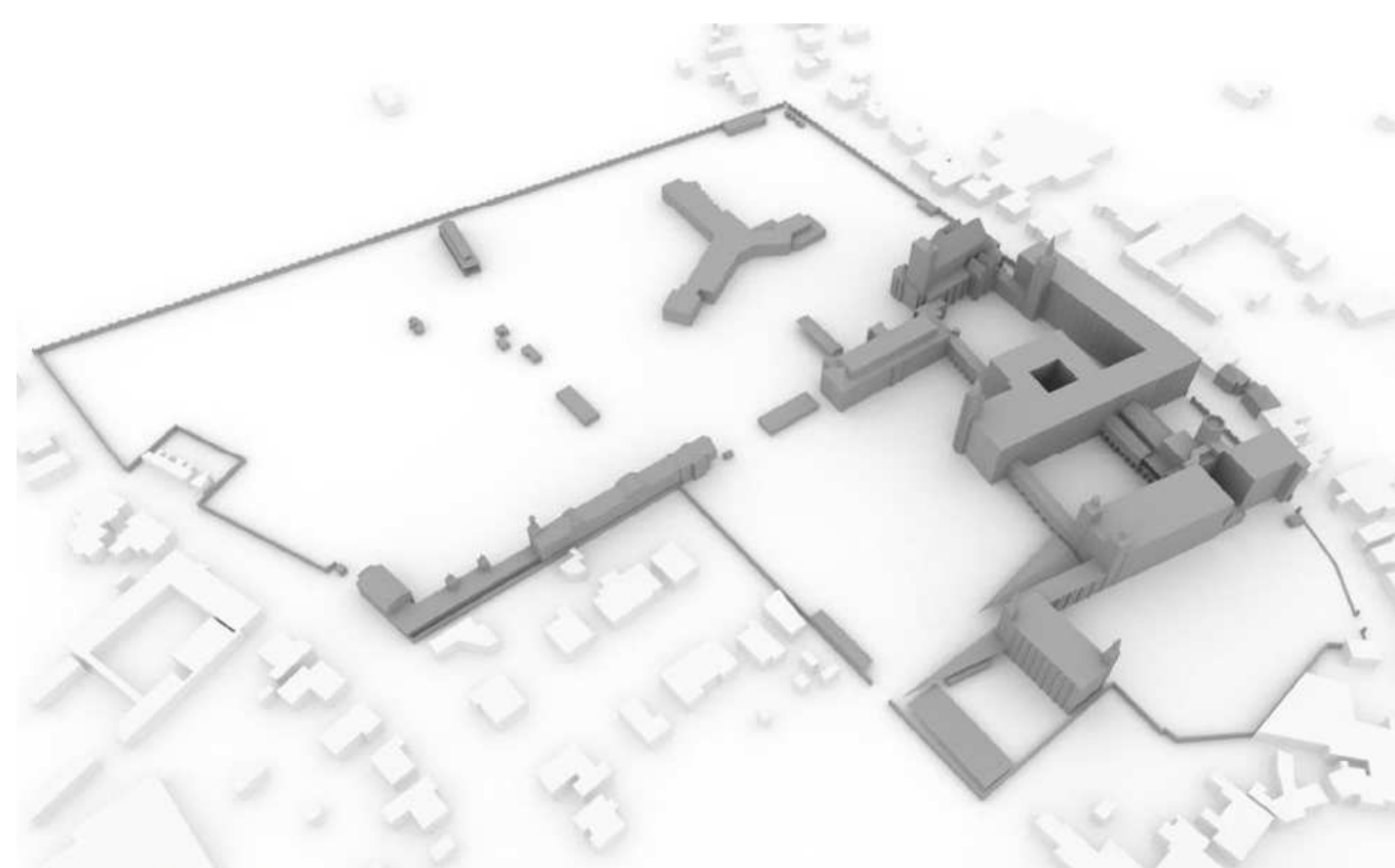

The Churches Conservation Trust

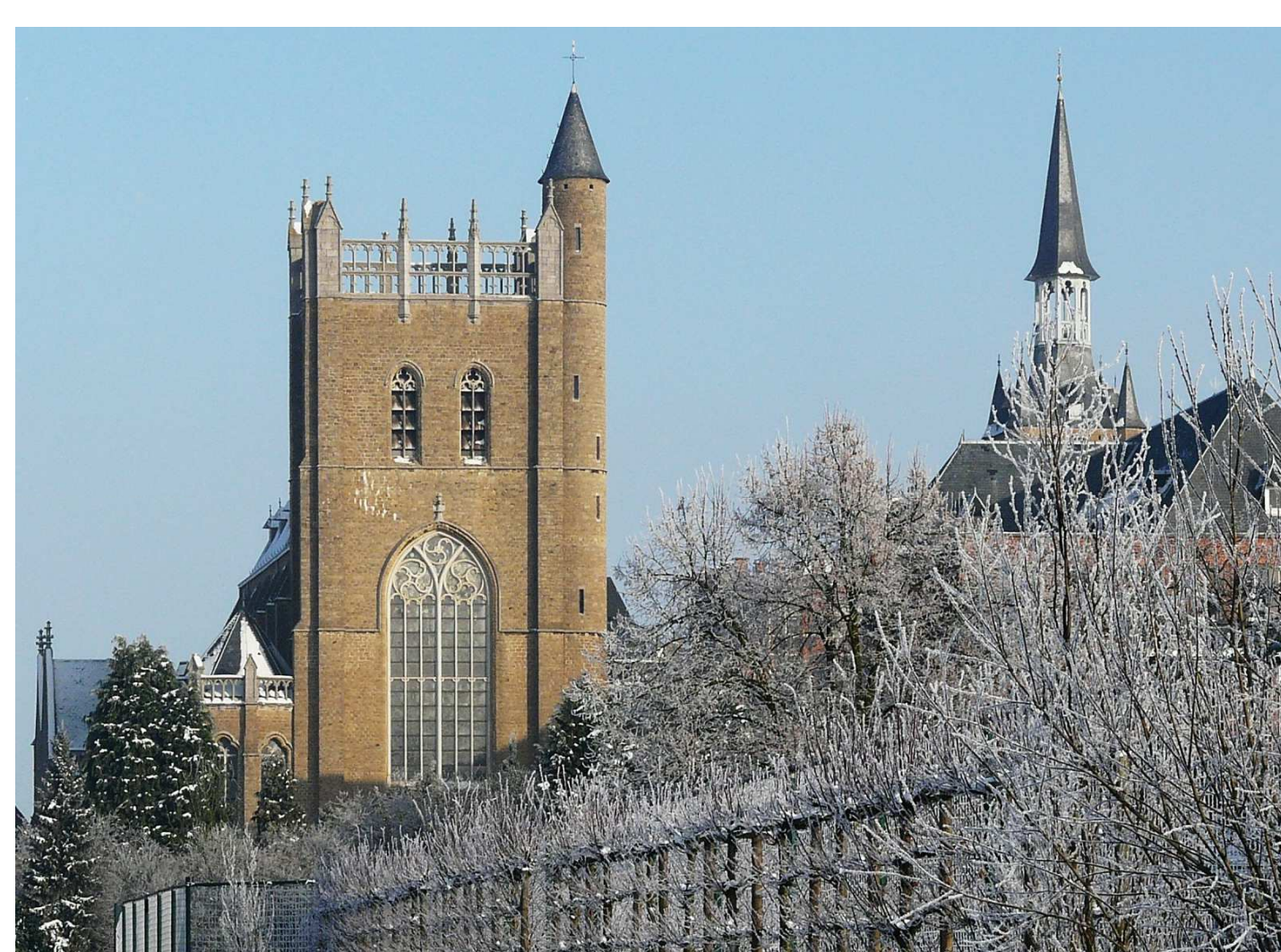
